Application Process

Students must:

- Write a one page typed letter (8 ½ x 11) addressed to “Cairns Family Scholarship” providing: details future education plans; explanation as to the disadvantages/adversity the student has met;
- Submit one general character reference from a non-family member in support of the application highlighting the applicant’s resiliency and ability to overcome adversity.

Applications will be received, reviewed and selected by the Principal and/or School Counselor of Mission Secondary School and Riverside College.
