C.U.P.E. Scholarship Criteria:

Applicant must be in Grade 12 in the school year in which they apply.

Applicants must enter an approved post secondary institution within two years of the award or the scholarship will be withdrawn.

Application must include:

- 1. **One page typed** autobiographical essay. (Font size no smaller than 11)
- 2. **One academic** reference letter (ie. teacher, counsellor, administrator).
- 3. One general reference letter from outside of school system (ie. employer, coach, minister, neighbour, etc.)
- 4. **One** copy of your transcript of grades.
- 5. Most recent grade 12 report card. (NOTE: Interim report not accepted)
