Graduate High School from Riverside College

- Students can attend Riverside College in their Grade 12 year and earn their high school diploma while at the same time working towards their future trade or career training program. Students will earn course credits towards graduation and trade or career certification.

Attend Riverside after High School Graduation

- Additionally, students may enroll at Riverside College after they graduate high school to complete a trade or career training program.

Most programs at Riverside College run 10 months, 5 days a week, beginning September of the school year. Our programs integrate both in class instruction and on the job training through our unique Work Study program, leading to opportunities for employment in the chosen field.
